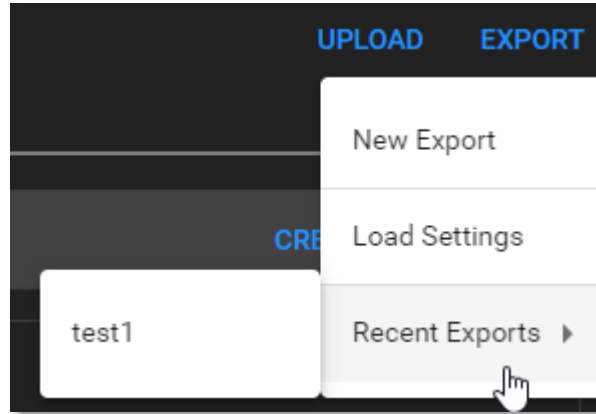

Wow! It's 2020 already! Hard to believe 2019 is already over. Welcome to the new decade! While many of us were off for the holiday break, our development team was hard at work rolling out some large and highly requested features. Check out new features and enhancements below:

New Features:

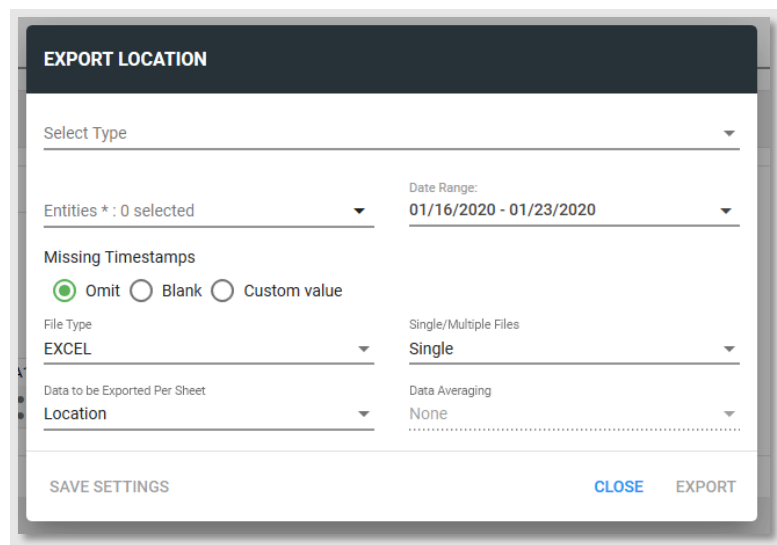
- **New Options for New Site Setup** – Users now can import location information XML files for sites that already exist in PRISM. This is a good step forward for those proactive teams that may want to set up a new site on the map in PRISM, and then upload its XML location information file later once the site is set up. Before the XML location import was only available for files as they were uploaded. Now the import button is enabled for the XML file in the Vault.

- **Save Export Settings!** – Users now can save\reload settings for data export - This is a huge new feature. The user can now easily save their export settings and reload them later so they are not required to reset/redefine export options each time they want to perform an export. We even have quick and easy access to a list of Most Recently Used export settings for the last 10 exports used! Nice Dev team!



- **Vault export to Excel! I repeat Vault export to Excel!** – Not only can we now export data by either Location or Location Group to an Excel file (.xlsx), users now have options to select one location, multiple locations, or All Locations for export. Other options include the ability to select different entities, date ranges, handling of missing timestamps, export of data to “one site per sheet”, “One Entity per Sheet”, or even splitting out into multiple XLSX files.

The Dev Team has built some crazy good functionality into the data export function! Well done!



- **Vault export of multiple locations to single csv file** – Again, this is a big win for the users! This has been a big requested feature, allowing users to export one location, multiple locations, All Locations to a single CSV file.

This is available in the same Export feature noted above.

- **Audit log** now available to all users under Reports to show what has happened for this customer
- The **Daily Summary report** now has the units in the header instead of in every cell - Another highly requested enhancement from users.

Important bugs resolved:

- FIXED – Dark Theme users could not see Temp entity as it was plotted as black
- FIXED – Flagged data from PROFILE was not getting flagged when imported into PRISM
- FIXED – KML layer had been added to map legend even if customer did not have that feature enabled. This was confusing and has been removed
- FIXED – Vault -> Export - Export button was not enabling if had originally entered incorrect date values but then corrected to valid dates
- FIXED – Users with non-email address logins were not able to successfully save their notification subscriptions

So, what's next?

The development team is focused on finishing the initial version of Data Editing, Reporting enhancements, enhancements to experience, along with constant bug fixes, optimizations, and efficiency improvements across the board. The PRISM team always welcomes comments, suggestions, requests, and bug notification. We also love hearing about your experience with PRISM – good and ugly – and use that input to energize the team or identify opportunity in the next sprint.
