The new release of PRISM (3.0.4) is here! This release includes some exciting new product features.


New features and enhancements include:

- GIS Improvements
  - Labels You will now notice that PRISM GIS shows labels for ADS monitors. You can turn these labels on or off on the Layers tab by clicking this icon.



- Highlight PRISM GIS now has a better highlight of selected features. All features will be highlighted in dark blue and the feature that is selected in the tree on the Tools tab will be in purple. You will see the purple feature change as you change your selection in the tree.
- **Toast Messages** You will notice that the messages that appear in PRISM will now be displayed longer and the error messages will now require you to press a **Dismiss** button for them to disappear.
- **FTP Sweep** We have taken another step as part of PRISM's ongoing efforts to import 3<sup>rd</sup> party data. We can now sweep CSV files from an FTP. Currently these must be in the PRISM CSV format. We are working on other formats and will provide updates as soon as possible.
- Quick Help We have pushed updates and created help for several of the pages. We are not done, but we are getting there.

- **Security** Security is always our utmost concern. We are constantly pushing updates to PRISM and our infrastructure to ensure that we are as secure as possible.
- **Scattergraphs on Custom Dashboard** You can now add scattergraph charts on the Custom Dashboard. You can plot scatterplots from multiple locations all on the same graph.



• **Bugs** – As always, there were many bugs that were resolved.

## So, what's next?

The development team will be working on some new scattergraph curve options, enhancements to drag & drop data editing, and updates to the Flow Monitoring Report. The PRISM team always welcomes comments, suggestions, requests, and bug notifications. We also love hearing about your experience with PRISM, (good or bad). We will use your input to energize the team and identify opportunities for further improvements in the next sprint.
